Selections may be made from the following options:

### **EVERYDAY ATTIRE: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday**

- solid-color polo shirts, solid-color rugby shirts, white or blue oxford shirts
- khaki long, short or cargo pants (*for boys*)
- khaki long or cropped pants, skirt/skort options (*for girls*)
- sweaters with the school logo or Canterbury sweatshirts
- athletic/tennis shoes, loafers, boots, casual shoes, sandals
- polar fleece jacket or vest with school logo

### **CHAPEL ATTIRE: Wednesday (Grades 5-7)**

- white or blue oxford shirts with khaki bottoms
- loafers or dress shoes
- EIGHTH GRADE students may choose to wear upper school Chapel attire (*see Upper School Dress Code*)

### **SPIRIT ATTIRE: Friday**

- Everyday Attire (*see above*)
- Canterbury t-shirts
- khaki bottoms or jeans
- plaid Bermuda-length walking shorts

### **DRESS-UP DAYS: Award Ceremonies**

Students will be notified in advance of all dress-up days. Middle school students will follow upper school dress-up day attire. (*See Upper School Dress Code.*)

### **DRESS DOWN DAYS: by announcement**

Dress Down Days are held for specific causes and announced in advance. For a donation, students may wear non-dress code attire. Shorts must be appropriate length (just above the knee), and hats may not be worn inside the buildings.

P.E. uniforms are required for all middle school students. **Closed-toe shoes must be worn in the laboratories, scene shop and stage area.**

### **The following clothing or styles are never acceptable:**

*miniskirts; short shorts; athletic shorts; t-shirts or shirts with pictures, numbers or any graphics other than manufacturer's name; frayed clothing; swimwear; visible underwear; visible body piercing other than ears; military or occupational uniforms; wallet chains; headgear (except for religious purposes); unusual color or cuts of hair; athletic or thong sandals, beach shoes, or flip-flops; sleeveless, low-cut, tank, midriff, halter, see-through or spaghetti-strap tops; ladies' bare midriff, cleavage, visible tattoos.*
