SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS

PreK-Grade 4 supplies are provided on the first day of school. Supplies for **Grades 9-12 will be specified by each teacher** on the first day of class. Contact the Division Principal or course instructor for additional information.

Supply lists for **Grades 5-8** are *suggestions* for all middle school students; other items may be needed as the year progresses.

Middle School (Grades 5-8)

All students are expected to have colored binders and loose leaf paper. The binders will need multiple tab dividers. Binders should combine at least two classes for efficient organization. In a pencil pouch, students should keep a supply of pencils, red, blue, and black pens, highlighters, colored pencils and a ruler calibrated in centimeters and inches. PE uniforms are required and may be purchased using the enclosed Middle School PE Uniform Order Form.
